

Reality Enrichment and Life Lessons (REALL) Simulation



Ozark Action, Inc. is now offering REALL (**Reality Enrichment and Life Lessons**) Simulations. The REALL Simulation is designed to address decision making in the youth population. During the simulation, youth will be presented with the opportunity to live two adult lives. During the first section of the simulation experience, youth will be presented with the opportunity to live the life of someone who has made reactive (negative) decisions and must now face potential consequences of such decisions. During the second section of the simulation experience, youth will be presented with the opportunity to live the life of someone who has completed their high school education and made proactive (positive) decisions. The debriefing section of the simulation will allow youth to reflect on the contrast between the experiences of both sections of the simulation.

The REALL simulation is used best to serve youth participants between the ages of 14-17 and takes no more than **3 hours**. Youth should be mature enough to understand potentially problematic choices such as substance abuse, school failure, delinquency, or early, unprotected sexual activity.

By allowing youth to participate in this simulation, you will have a hand in teaching youth about decision-making and potential consequences of decisions. The simulation is designed to be an immersive experience for youth participants.

The simulation can accommodate up to 60 participants per simulation. Fewer participants may be used; however, it is recommended that a minimum of 30+ participants engage in the simulation to ensure a productive experience.
